Drew's Views – Bikes to Trikes



Let's face it. Every motorcyclist, even the GOATs, from motocross (Ricky Carmichael) to road (Giacomo Agostini) to flat track (Jay Springsteen) and other crazy motorcycle fanatics (Evel Knievel, Don Ambrose) there comes a time when ya gots to decide to get off two wheels. We have two options: stop riding or get a **Harley trike**. As such, my last "Views" item of 2024 focuses on three wheelers. As in most of my articles, I'll draw some info from publicly available subject-matter expertise available on the Internet.

First, a nod to safety. In general, the jury rules trikes are safer than standard motorcycles. They have more rubber on the road, which means they can stop faster. Trikes are wider, more grounded, and heavier than motorcycles. This results in more stability. Larger dimensions make them more visible in traffic and offer more protection. Riders have a better view of the traffic. Trikes can easily go over dirt and gravel roads, as well as metal grated bridges. The need to balance at slow speeds; non-existent. No one has ever dropped one, to my knowledge. More comfortable; an important consideration for long rides. More cargo capacity. I can't think of any downside safety-wise.

However, comma, safety aside...Trikes cost more to buy and maintain. Potential storage and parking issues. They don't take corners as well. Other matters? I'll defer to the Chapter's trike owners. We'll cover this topic in a future WWR discussion.

Remember I mentioned my special camera a few months ago which can take pictures of

the future? (Saw that on Twilight Zone, to be honest!) The problem is it doesn't tell you "when" the future is. Ten minutes? Ten months? Ten years? I took this photo of Don last month.

When will we see this?


