The Helen, Georgia overnight ride will be leaving on Friday August 29th and returning on Monday (Labor Day) September 1st. Helen is an Alpine village nestled in the Blue Ridge Mountains of Northern Georgia on the Chattahoochee River.

On Saturday August 30th and Sunday August 31st Past Director/RC Rick Vincent will be leading chapter rides in Northern Georgia & North Carolina. These rides will include the Chattahoochee National Park, Two Wheels of Suches Motorcycle Campground (Sunday breakfast), riding past numerous lakes (Blue Ridge, Nottely, Chatuge, Burton, Rabun, Sequoyah, Thorpe Reservoir), a waterfall (Dry Falls-Highlands, NC), and numerous twisty mountain roads.

Hotel accommodations will be each rider's responsibility. Alpine Village Inn hotel has been contacted, and they currently have 10 rooms available but would not hold the rooms under a group reservation. Additionally, you must book the rooms under hotels.com. The rate is \$387 + tax for 3 nights. There are numerous other hotels in town but book early as hotels are booking up fast due to this being a holiday weekend.
